#### Reporting Identity Theft or Fraud

June 17, 2005

If you believe you have been a victim of Identity Theft or Fraud [call us \[1\]](#) and your credit card companies IMMEDIATELY.

#### To file a complaint with the Federal Trade Commission:

You can file a complaint online at [www.consumer.gov/idtheft \[2\]](http://www.consumer.gov/idtheft) or call the FTC's Identity Theft Hotline, toll-free at 1-877-IDTHEFT (438-4338)

#### To log a complaint with the Internet Crime Complaint Center (IC3):

This is the national repository for Internet Fraud Complaints. Just complete an online complaint form at [www.IC3.gov \[3\]](http://www.IC3.gov) that will be processed by the FBI.

#### Placing a Fraud Alert on your File:

You have a right to place a fraud alert on your credit file, for 90 days. The law also allows you to put an extended fraud alert on your credit file under certain circumstances. Contact any Credit Bureau listed below:
